Rounds:	Saturday - Double WA70m/60m/50m & 50m Barebow Round. Sunday - WA1440 90m, 70m & 60m (50+ available both days) Accompanied Juniors are welcome but there are no separate rounds or categories.
Sunday Format:	6 arrow ends at all distances. Compound & Recurve will shoot on individual reduced faces at the 2 shortest distances.
Targets:	All bowstyles will shoot on layered foam targets.
Guest of Honour:	TBA
Judges:	Phil Collins, Paul Richards, Jane Cotttee & Matt Carstensen.
Registration:	Available from 08:00 each day. AGB membership will be checked on line upon entry.
Kit Inspection:	Will take place each day prior to assembly.
Awards:	Archers shooting the 50+ category will not be eligible for ranking points.
Entry Fees:	£17.00 per day.
Event Timings:	Assembly 09:00 - Followed by 45 minutes practice - Shooting from 10:00
Shooting Rules & Drug Testing:	The tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Archers competing at World Record events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
Smoking:	Smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes) is only permitted behind the tents. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.
Animals:	Only registered assistance dogs are permitted on the field and MUST be kept on a lead and remain behind the waiting line at all times.
Refreshments:	A selection of hot and cold food and drinks will be available throughout the weekend.
Camping:	Overnight camping is very limited and strictly by prior arrangement with the T.O.
Car Parking:	Car parking is available adjacent to the shooting ground.
