**Awards:** This is a team event and as such there is no individual awards. A beautiful trophy is awarded to the winning team, with medals to all six of the first, second and third team members. You are welcome to have more than one team, submitting one form per team. On the day, for each team, select the four best handicap adjusted scores, to include at least one of the opposite sex. The handicap is based on bow type not archer ability.

**Dress Code:** AGB rule 307 will apply.

**Juniors:** Juniors are welcome but will be shooting the same distances and must be accompanied by their Parent or Guardian.

## History

The FoBB Anniversary Team Challenge Shoot is shot on the late May Bank Holiday Monday each year between teams from local clubs. The shoot was inaugurated in May 1994 to celebrate the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Forest of Bere Bowmen in 1974.

The trophy is a silver bear overlooking a pool and mounted on a wooden base. It was presented by Pat and Brian Williams, two of FoBB's founder members.

## Rules

1. The round is a Western round; four dozen arrows each at distances of 60y and 50y on a 122cm target face
2. Teams are entered by various clubs, or organisations.
3. Each club enters a maximum of six archers and selects four of their scores to be put forward to the scoring
  - a. Teams must contain a mix of genders
4. All bow styles are permitted and are handicapped by bow style and archer's gender as per the table below
5. The team of four archers with the highest total handicap adjusted score will be the winners
  - a. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest total of golds will prevail
  - b. In the event of a further tie, the team with the highest total number of hits will prevail
6. Medals will be awarded to all six archers in the squad of each of the top three clubs; Gold, Silver and Bronze
