- Event Timings:** Assembly 09:45 - Followed by sighters - Shooting from 10:00
- Shooting Rules & Drug Testing:** The tournament will be shot to Archery GB rules in force at the time. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Archers competing at Record Status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
- Smoking:** Smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes) is only permitted behind the tents. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.
- Animals:** Only registered assistance dogs are permitted on the field and MUST be kept on a lead and remain behind the waiting line at all times.
- Refreshments:** A selection of hot and cold food and drinks will be available throughout the day.
- Camping:** Overnight camping is very limited and strictly by prior arrangement with the T.O.
- Car Parking:** Car parking is available adjacent to the shooting ground.
