

FoBB Digital Presence


As those of you who have been on the FoBB website recently will have realised, we now have a new website that is a lot more 21st century in its design and operation. We've moved to a new hosting provider and updated the website so that it's more user friendly and also more device friendly on mobile phones and tablets, though you should still get a good experience viewing it from a PC or laptop. A lot of the content has been updated from the old website but if you think there are things that are missing, or if you have any material that you'd like to contribute to the website then your contributions would be very welcome!

The new website also has improved security, using HTTPS connectivity and we've moved away from the old model of having one username and password to access the members only area. To access this you can now register individually and, once approved and authorized, you'll have individual access to the members only content, including Club Records, Archer Handicaps, The 252 scheme, Meeting Minutes and the back issues of Bere Facts.

From the members area you'll also have access to the new online club records system, from where you can view all of the score records that you have with the club and where you can add any scores you achieve at away shoots. You'll also be able to view your handicap and classification achievements, both past and current. This is held in a separate system, linked to the core club records and updated regularly. You'll receive a separate invitation to connect to this system when you register as a member on the website.

We hope that you'll enjoy the new systems and that you'll feel able to contribute material to keep them lively and up to date. If you have any comments or suggestions, please email them to web@fobb.uk
