From the South:

Exit Junction 2 of the A3(M) and turn right, (signposted Horndean). Go over the motorway and turn left at the next roundabout. Carry on towards Horndean and just before the mini roundabout, turn right (signposted Blendworth). Carry on past the fire station. The range is within the grounds of Cadlington House on the right. Turn into the drive and as you approach the house, turn right down the track in front of the flint wall. As the track bends to the left, you will see a five-bar gate in front of you. Go through the gate into the car park.

From the North:

Turn off onto the A3 towards Horndean, do not carry on to the motorway A3(M). Go past the Ship and Bell public house on the left. At the mini-roundabout go left and then take the immediate left, up Blendworth Lane, towards Blendworth. Carry on past the fire station. The range is within the grounds of Cadlington House on the right. Turn into the drive and as you approach the house, turn right down the track in front of the flint wall. As the track bends to the left, you will see a five-bar gate in front of you. Go through the gate into the car park.
